Plaintiffs/intervenors may reply in support of their motion by 5:00 p.m. on Monday 8/31/2015. Nothing in this Court's Order or previous Order was intended to mandate payments be made on a faster schedule than they would have been made, as the parties agreed, in FY 2015.
