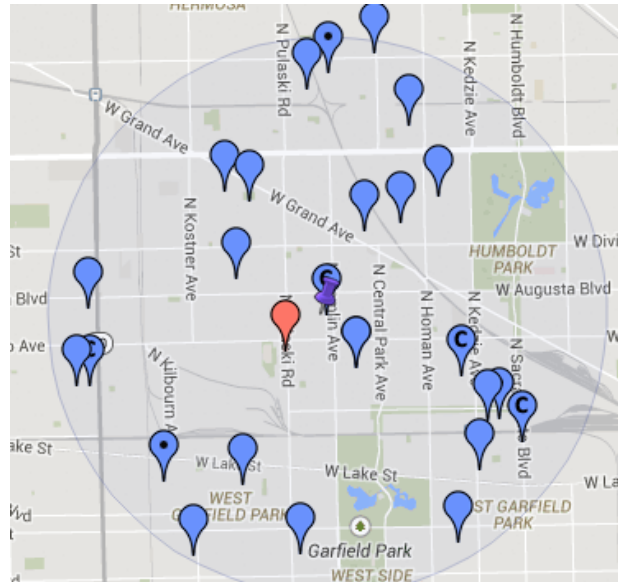
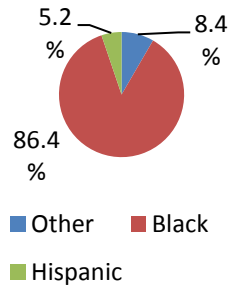
Elementary School

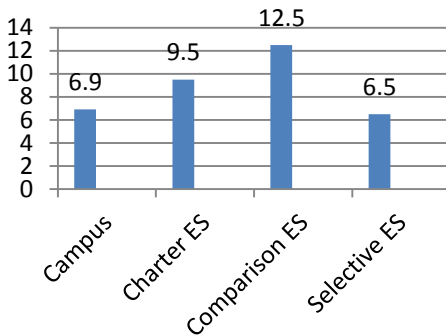

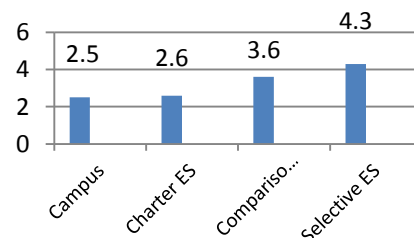

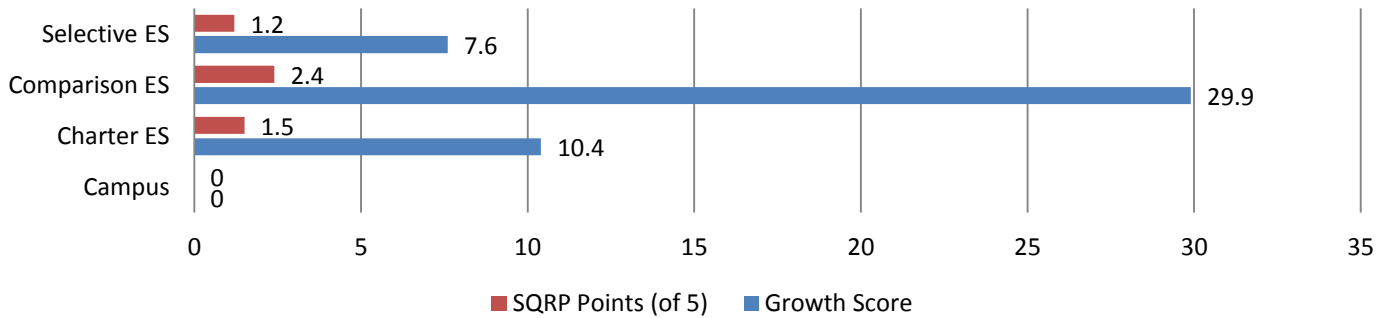
Total Quality Score



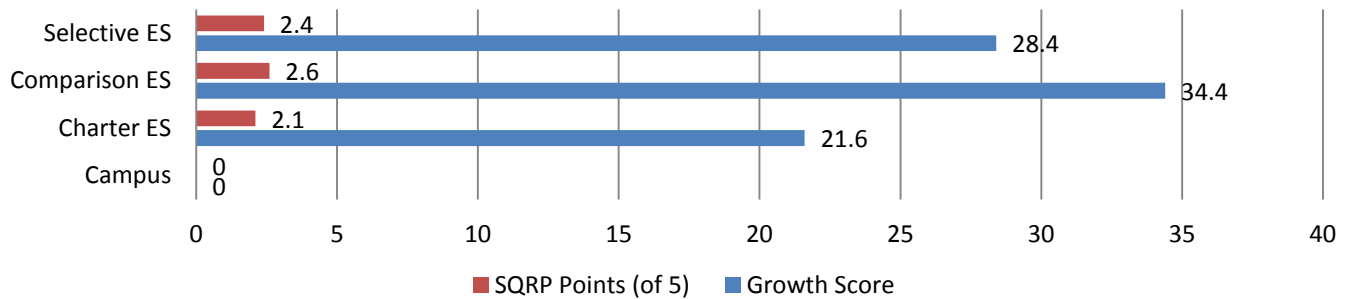

Enrollment Trends

Galapagos's mobility rate for the 2012-13 school year, according to CPS, is 20.0%, compared to 12.0% for charter elementary schools, 22.8% for comparison schools, and 6.0% at selective schools.

Percent of students who unenroll from the school for *any reason*

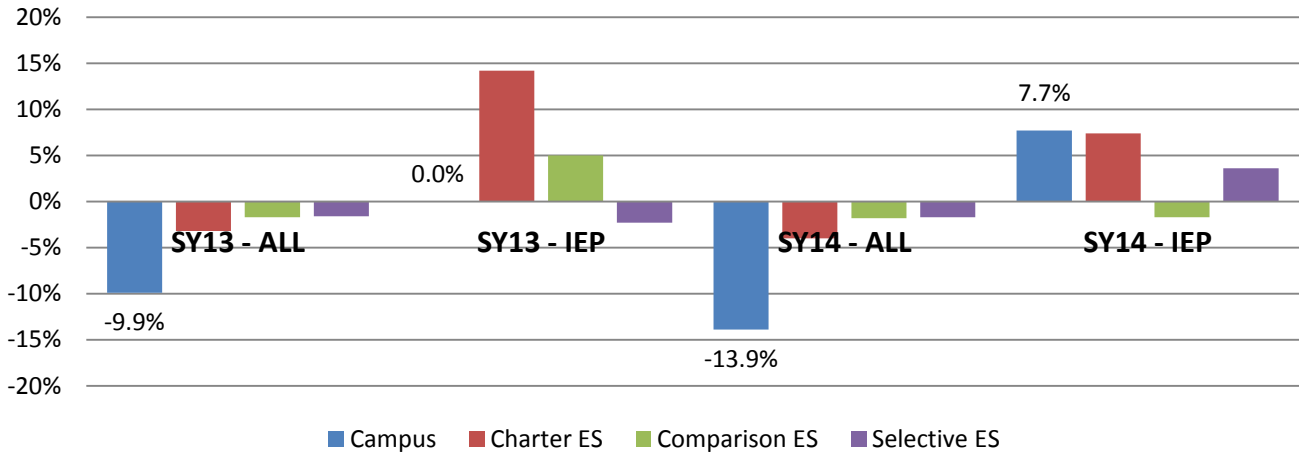

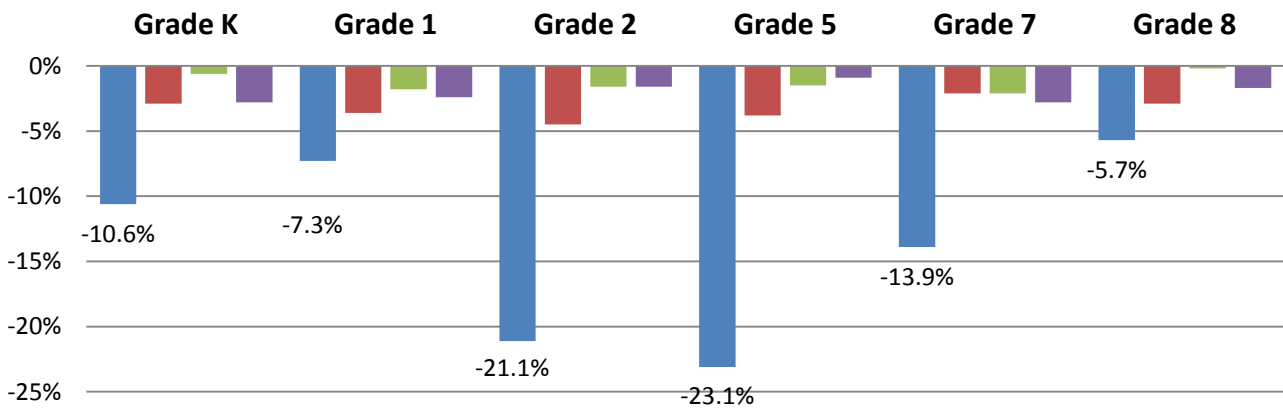

Average Net Enrollment Change during SY 2013-14

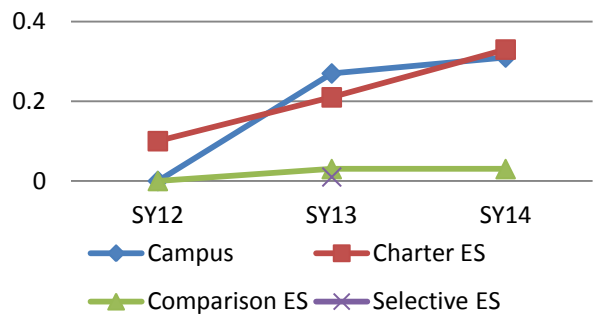
