

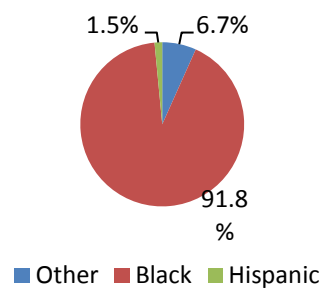


LEARN - Excel Elementary School

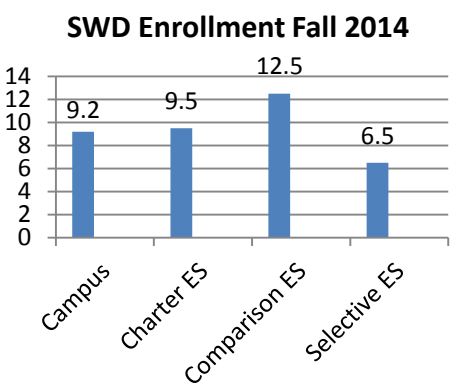

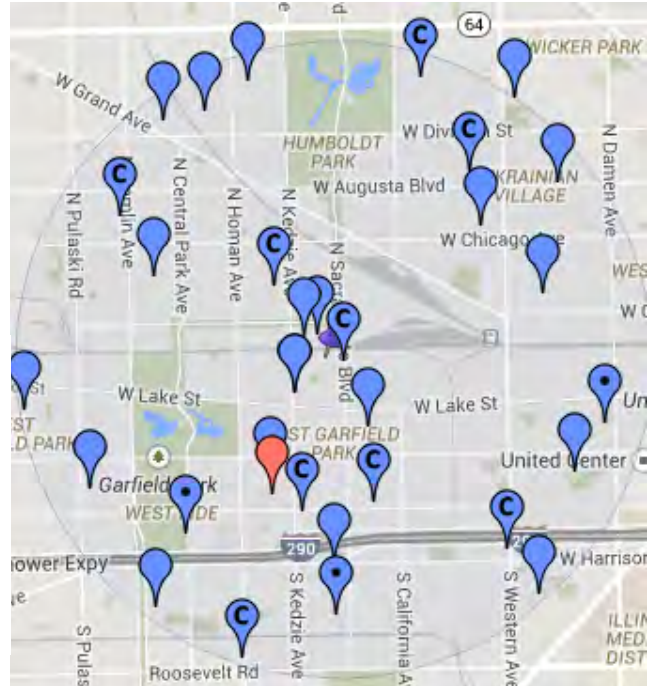

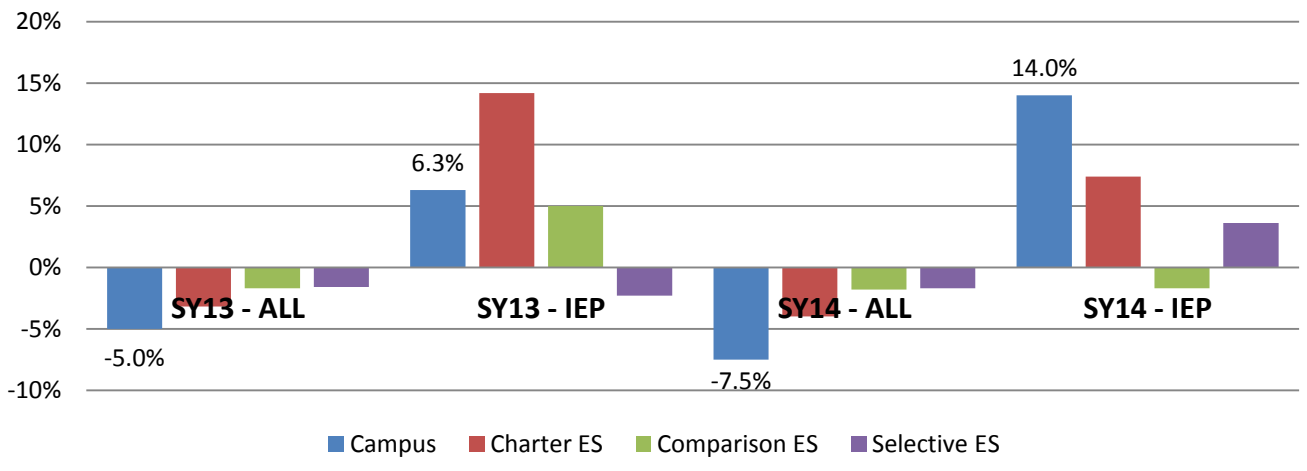

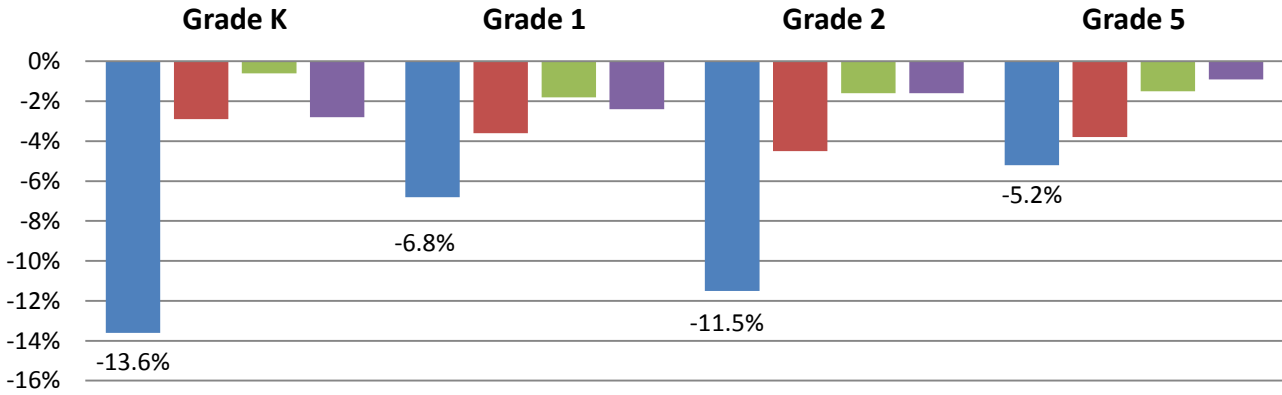

Average Net Enrollment Change during SY 2013-14

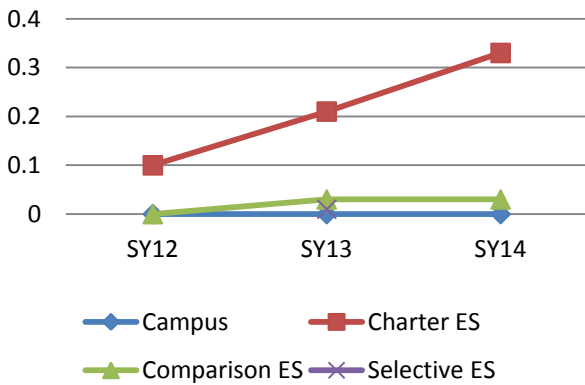
