The University of Chicago Charter School in collaboration with the Ounce of Prevention Fund offers prekindergarten for three-year-olds at Ounce's Educare School and early admission to kindergarten at the University of Chicago Charter School effective for the **2017-2018 school year**. Educare is located at 5044 S. Wabash Avenue and has its own application form and Head Start eligibility criteria. **Interested families must submit the Educare application to Educare and the charter school application to the University of Chicago Charter School.** Only applicants that submit both applications and are admitted and enroll at Educare will be eligible for early admission to kindergarten at the University of Chicago Charter School.

To be considered for admission, applications must include all the following required documents:

Completed application form signed by parent/legal guardian

Copy of child's birth certificate.

If parent/legal guardian's name is not on birth certificate, other proof of legal guardianship is required.

Proof of Chicago residency

E.g. copy of recent mortgage statement, lease, utility (gas, electric, phone) bill, bank statement, paycheck stub, public aid medical card, insurance bill. Date, parent/guardian name, and address must be readable and match name on application form. Driver's license or other photo ID not accepted.

All applicants must be residents of the city of Chicago. Priorities will be given to the categories of applicants described below. If there are still openings available after priority applicants have been admitted, then they will be filled by a random lottery. Waitlists for each grade level will also be established by random lottery.

North Kenwood/Oakland Campus

Applications will be accepted for prekindergarten through grade five, with openings expected in prekindergarten and kindergarten.

Admissions priority will be given to applicants for open seats in this order:

9th Grade:

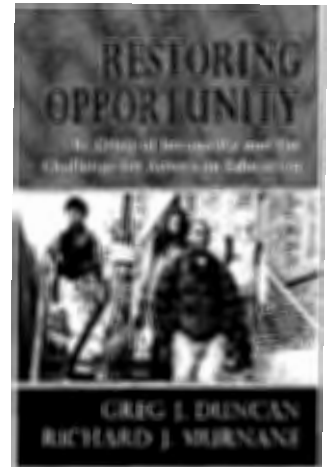

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Admissions Process

By state law, families who apply to the University of Chicago Charter School on behalf of their children must reside within the Chicago city limits. UChicago Charter uses no selection criteria. Students are admitted by lottery.

All campuses of the University of Chicago Charter School have attendance boundaries assigned to them by the Chicago Public Schools.

Applicants to these campuses who are residents of the relevant attendance zone are given admissions priority. Additionally, admissions priority is given to applicants who are siblings of currently enrolled students.

UChicago Charter generally makes applications available in October with a final due date in late February to early March, followed by a public lottery held in late March. Families may apply to more than one campus. Applications are good for one year only—any applicants who are not admitted in one year must reapply the next year.
